Interfaces in Energy Materials Horizons Conference presented by APL Materials

Approximately 100 delegates convened on Trinity College at the University of Cambridge April 10-12 to attend the fourth installment of the AIP Publishing Horizons conference series, the Interfaces in Energy Materials Conference presented by *APL Materials*. The aim of the conference was to identify common challenges and build on knowledge scattered across the several otherwise disparate subfields in energy materials. Speakers presented brand new findings in the areas of thermoelectrics, solid-state batteries, solid-oxide fuel cells and interface electronics.

A panel discussion at the end of the conference provided an opportunity for the speakers and attendees to

summarize what they had learned, reiterate the importance of interfaces in materials, and establish a stronger connection between theorists and experimentalists working on similar systems. Overall, the conversations that occurred at the meeting provided conference attendees with valuable insight into the future of energy materials.


